Baseline Household Projections for the Next Decade and Beyond

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Introduction

This paper updates the Joint Center for Housing Studies (JCHS) household projections¹ by incorporating updates to its three key data inputs: the Census Bureau 2012 Population Projections (released in late 2012 and early 2013) and headship rates (ratios of households per person) derived from the 2011-2013 Current Population Estimates and Current Population Survey March Supplements. Aside from the new data, the JCHS projection methodology remains largely unchanged from that used to create the 2010 series. However, the 2013 JCHS household projections no longer involve adjustments to the Census Bureau population series in the form of downward revisions in the Census Bureau's estimates of immigration levels, which now are in keeping with previous JCHS estimates. Additionally, in using the 2012 Census population projections as published, the 2013 JCHS household projections now contain high, middle, and low series, whereas the 2010 projections only had a high and a low series. The projections are also carried out an additional ten years, and so now extend to 2035.

The results of the 2013 JCHS household projections are largely consistent with those from 2010. The range of household growth levels in the 2013 high, middle, and low series roughly corresponds to that from the 2010 high and low projections. For example, for 2015-2025, the new 2013 projections call for annual household growth rates ranging from 1.16 million in the low series to 1.32 million in the high series, not far from the span of 1.15–1.36 million per year in the 2010 JCHS projections.

Also, as was the case for the 2010 projections, the 2013 JCHS household projections should be considered baseline projections and not a growth forecast. Actual household growth could deviate dramatically from that in the projections over short periods of time, as the projections reflect long-run, demographically driven trends and do not allow for any adjustments either upward or downward in response to changing economic conditions or cyclical factors. For example, these projections hold current household formation rates (headship rates) constant throughout the projection period, and therefore account for neither the existence of pent-up demand in today's market nor further declines in headship that may occur if economic conditions deteriorate. Indeed, favorable economic conditions could increase headship rates above levels assumed in the projection, which would increase the amount of household growth that occurs as a result of future projected population growth, while on the other

hand a variety of factors weighing down economic opportunities could result in lower household formation rates. But changes in headship rates would have a modest effect on the household projections relative to those produced by changes in the level of net foreign immigration, which remains the greatest source of sensitivity in the projections.

JCHS Household Projection Methodology

The basic methodology behind the JCHS household growth projections is to apply constant headship rates (that is, shares of population that are heads of household) for each five-year age group by race and ethnicity to Census Bureau population projections.² This involves using three Census data products as inputs: one for the population projections and two for calculating headship rates.

The fundamental data input to the JCHS household projections is the Census Bureau's Population Projections. The 2010 JCHS household projections used the Census Bureau's 2008 middle-series population projections with adjustments, while the 2013 JCHS household projections use the Bureau's updated 2012 population projections without adjustment. We made adjustments to the population projections in 2010 because we felt that the 2008 Census middle-series immigration assumptions were too aggressive. The 2010 JCHS low-series household projection was therefore based on the 2008 Census middle-series population projection with its immigration assumptions cut in half, while the high series was based on the 2008 Census middle-series population projections as published. With measures of actual immigration levels in recent years coming close to the reduced assumption, the JCHS low-series household growth projection has been considered the preferred series, though it remained plausible that immigration over the forward ten-year period could be higher. Because the 2012 Census Bureau population projections reduced assumed immigration levels, bringing them into line with the Joint Center's previous low-series assumption. As a result, the 2013 JCHS household projections use the low, middle, and high series from the Census as published, without further adjustment.

One consequence of making adjustments to the Census Bureau immigration assumptions used in the 2010 projections was that the projections were truncated to fifteen years, extending only to 2025. This

limitation was imposed because changes to the immigration assumptions would have increasingly large implications for future birth rates and therefore future population growth rates in the years beyond 2025 that could not be factored into the JCHS adjustments to the Census series. Because no adjustments were made to the 2012 Census projections, the 2013 JCHS projections extend forward to 2035.

To calculate headship rates by age and race/ethnicity, the JCHS household projections use household counts from the Current Population Survey March Supplements (CPS/ASEC) as the numerator, and population counts from Census Bureau July 1 Population Estimates as the denominator.³ The CPS/ASEC household counts are used because they are the timeliest and come closest to matching household counts from the decennial census. Population counts from the CPS/ASEC are not used as the denominator in the calculation because this survey does not count people living in institutional group quarters, and so using its population estimates would overstate headship rates. Starting with the 2010 household projections, headship rates are averaged over three years to reduce random survey volatility present in any one year of data due to the CPS/ASEC's relatively small sample size. In the 2010 household projections, headship rates were averaged across years 2007, 2008, and 2009, while the 2013 projections use years 2011, 2012, and 2013. A single set of estimated headship rates are used for all projection series, where they are held constant across years.

In summary, since the publication of the 2010 JCHS household projections, each of the Census data inputs has been updated, or re-benchmarked, to incorporate the results of the 2010 decennial census – the Census Bureau's benchmark survey that offers the largest and most representative count of people and households in the US. The 2013 JCHS household projections now use the 2012 Census Bureau high-, middle-, and low-series population projections, and headship rate data derived from the CPS/ASEC and averaged across years 2011, 2012, and 2013.


The 2013 JCHS Household Projections

The 2013 JCHS household projections, shown in full in Appendix A, were produced by applying the same household projection methodology used in 2010 to these new data series. These new 2013 projections


Figure 1. Updated JCHS 2013 Household Projections Fall within the 2010 Projections, Reflecting Modest Changes to the Underlying Data

of household counts remain in line with projections from 2010 over the next ten-year period, but the range of the 2013 projections covers a much narrower span for the next decade (**Figure 1**).

Overall, household growth rates in the 2013 JCHS projections differ only modestly from those in the 2010 projections (**Figure 2**). For the years in which they overlap, the new 2013 projections mostly fall within the span of the 2010 low and high projections. However, the 2013 household projections show a greater decline in growth rates over time, following underlying trends in adult population growth in the 2012 Census population projections. This decline is such that by 2025, growth rates in the new 2013 JCHS low-series household projections dip below those of the 2010 JCHS low-series projections and continue to decline in the years beyond. In all, baseline annual household growth rates in the 2013 JCHS projections span from 1.31-1.36 million households per year in years 2013-15, slowing to a rate of 1.23-1.34 million households per year in 2015-2020, then to 1.09-1.30 million in years 2020-2025, and then dropping even further in the following decade (**Table 1**).

The 2013 JCHS household projections also reflect a very similar distribution of household growth by age, race and ethnicity as compared to the 2010 projections. Like the total household counts, there is also less variation between the low and the high series in 2013 than in 2010 (**Table 2**). Similar to the 2010 projections, the 2013 JCHS projections show minorities making up the majority of household growth in the coming decades. For the 2015-2025 ten-year period, for instance, minorities account for just over 76 percent of all household growth under each of the three series, with Hispanics alone accounting for 40 percent of total household growth. The 2013 JCHS household projections also document the rapid aging of the population, as households over age 65 are estimated to make up an even higher share of total household growth than in the 2010 projections. In fact, the increase of at least 10.6 million households age 65 or older is equivalent to 91 percent of the net change in the number of US households under the low projection and 81 percent in the high projection. The increase reflects both a decrease in assumed mortality rates for older adults and lower estimates for immigration among younger adults compared to those used in the 2008 Census population projections.

As shown in Table 2, the 2013 JCHS household projections also include household counts by household type. Unlike other characteristics such as age and race/ethnicity, however, these counts are determined after the projections are complete, as household types do not factor into the making of the projections. The methodology assumes that the current distribution of household types within each age and race/ethnicity group will hold steady over time, and simply allocates projected households using this

distribution. This is the same methodology used in the 2010 JCHS projections, but with updated data. Whereas the 2010 JCHS projections used the distributions of households by type from the 2007, 2008, and 2009 CPS/ASEC, the 2013 JCHS projections average 2012 and 2013 data.

The 2013 JCHS projections are similar to the 2010 projections in terms of the household types that are expected to make up the largest shares of household growth over the next decade. These results reflect the extent to which household growth by type is driven by the age distribution of the population. With over 90 percent of household growth among households over age 65, it is not surprising that single-person (4.4-4.7 million) and married-without-children households (4.0-4.3 million) will together comprise nearly three quarters of all household growth in the upcoming 2015-2025 ten-year period. In each of the three 2013 projections, married-with-children households are also projected to grow by over 1 million during those ten years, reflecting the aging of the large echo-boom/millennial generation into the 35-to-44-year-old age group, where the proportion of such households is highest.

Projecting Scenarios for Household Growth by Tenure


The 2013 JCHS household projections can also be used to provide a simple, baseline tenure projection by applying current homeownership rates for each five-year age, race/ethnicity, and household-type category and applying them to associated projected counts of households. This results in a projection for the future number of homeowners given a scenario where current homeownership rates hold constant. However, since homeownership rates can vary significantly over the span of a few years – as was seen recently in the sharp decline in homeownership rates since 2005 – this method provides only a rough sketch of potential future trends under a very restrictive assumption. Homeownership rates will be affected by changes not only in preferences for owning, but also by changes in employment and income among different demographic segments, interest rates, home prices and expectations about future movements in prices, and the availability of mortgage credit. Nonetheless, while admittedly crude, this simple approach to projecting trends in the numbers of owners and renters does provide some insight into how expected changes to the number and demographic composition of households may exert pressure on homeownership and rental markets in the future.

The tenure projections begin by obtaining average homeownership rates from the 2012 and 2013 CPS/ASEC by age, race and household-type categories – the same categories presented in the 2013 JCHS household projections. The rates are averaged across two years to reduce volatility in the underlying CPS/ASEC survey data given the small sample size of some of our cells. We then apply this grid of homeownership rates to the 2013 JCHS household projections to get a projection of homeowner households. We then subtract these homeowner households from the total household projections to estimate the number of renter households. This is done for the low, middle, and high 2013 JCHS household projections to get three series. Each of these series applies the same, constant, homeownership rates.

The resulting homeowner and renter projections are shown in full in Appendix B. Results show that under this scenario of constant homeownership rate, the rate of growth in homeowners is projected to range from 780 to 860 thousand per year in the ten-year period from 2015 to 2025, slowing to a pace of 530 to 700 thousand households per year in 2025-2035. The pace of renter household growth is expected to decline much less over time than that of homeowners under the low projection, and even to accelerate through 2035 under the high projection. Overall, renter household growth is expected to range from 380 to 460 thousand per year during the 2015-2025 period and 340 to 500 thousand per year in 2025-2035.

Given that homeownership rates by age, race, and household type are being held constant, the differences in the growth rates of homeowner and renter households also underscore the demographic influence on future homeownership rates (**Figure 3**). Under each projection, changing demographics are expected to be a positive influence on the overall homeownership rate through about 2025. After that time, the upward influence of the aging of the population gives way to greater downward pressure from young adult and minority household growth. With higher immigration assumptions, post-2025 declines in homeownership rate expectations are steeper in the middle and high projections than in the low.

Note: Homeownership rates by age, race/ethnicity, and household-type are held constant.



Sources of Difference between the 2010 and 2013 JCHS Household Projections

Many of the differences between the 2010 and 2013 JCHS household growth projections result from changes to the underlying Census Bureau projections for the adult population between 2008 and 2012. The 2012 Census Bureau population projections incorporate new population counts from the 2010 decennial census and also revised assumptions for future net international immigration and the other key components of population change – birth and death rates. These changes resulted in population projections that were much lower than those from the 2008 series, with a much narrower gap between high and low projections. Comparing the middle series of the 2012 projections with the middle series of the 2008 projections for years 2015-2025, population growth among people aged 15 and over is revised downward by 5.3 million people, or fully 20 percent – from 26.6 million to 20.9 million. Even the high-series 2012 projection shows less adult population growth, by 1.4 million people, than the previous low-series projection.


Figure 4. Differences Between the 2010 and 2013 JCHS Household Projections Largely Follow Changes to the Underlying Census Bureau Population Projections

That the population projections from 2008 were revised downward in 2012 is not surprising. The 2008 projections were viewed at the time as aggressive and high. For this reason, the 2010 JCHS projections used the Census Bureau's 2008 middle-series population projections as the basis for its high-series household projections; to calculate its low-series household projections, the JCHS cut the immigration assumptions of the Bureau's 2008 middle-series population projections in half. This adjustment made for the 2010 JCHS projections appears to be justified by the new Census Bureau projections. As shown in Figure 4, the low-series population growth projected by the JCHS in 2010 is right in line with the Census Bureau's 2012 low-series population projections – at least through the early 2020s (**Figure 4**). At the same time, for the years 2012-2015, the Bureau's 2012 high-series population projections have growth rates that average approximately 300,000 people per year less than the rates used to project the 2010 JCHS high series, showing why there is greater difference between the JCHS high-series household growth projections of 2013 and 2010 than between its low-series projections.


Figure 5. Past and Projected Net Immigration Levels Show A High Degree of Variability

Lower immigration assumptions are the biggest source of difference between the 2012 and 2008 Census Bureau population projections, and are also the source for most of the difference between the high-, middle-, and low-series population projections in 2012 (**Figure 5**). Comparing just the middle series of 2012 and 2008, the 2012 middle series assumes average immigration levels of 900,000 per year in the 2015-2025 period, rising from approximately 800,000 in 2015 to 1.0 million in 2025. In comparison, the 2008 Census projections had assumed an average of 1.46 million immigrants per year across the period, rising from 1.38 million in 2015 up to 1.57 million by 2025. Including all ages, the level of population growth due to immigration in the 2012 middle-series Census population projection for the 2015-2025 period is fully 4.75 million less than what was called for in the 2008 middle-series population projection.


Figure 6. Lower Immigration Assumptions Account for Most of the Difference between the Census Bureau's 2008 and 2012 Projections for Adult Population Growth in 2015-2025

Expected change in the adult population due to natural growth of the native population (the net result of births and deaths) is also lower in the 2012 than in the 2008 middle-series Census Bureau population projections, but the difference is less stark than for immigration (**Figure 6**). In the ten-year period of 2015-2025, natural growth of the current adult population in the 2013 middle-series projections is just 1.2 million less than in 2008 – only about one quarter of the expected drop in immigration.


Figure 7. Declines in the Underlying Population Growth Projections Used in the 2013 JCHS Household Projections Were Not Evenly Split

The composition of population growth under the 2012 Census Bureau population projections also differs from that of the earlier projections; this difference also had an impact on the 2013 JCHS household growth projections. Comparing across races and ethnicities, the 2012 population projections show reduced population growth among Hispanics and whites, and little difference in projected growth among blacks, Asians, and other households (**Figure 7**). Specifically, across the 2015-2025 ten-year period, 2012 Census population projections for Hispanic population are between 90,000 and 200,000 per year lower than those used as a basis for the 2010 JCHS projections, with the greatest difference between the high series. Population growth among whites is also expected to be lower in the new projections, by about 110,000 to 140,000 people per year.

By age, the 2012 population projections for 2015-2025 show much less growth among the youngest adults under age 25, and moderately less growth in the number of older adults aged 45-64, than did the 2008 projections (**Figure 8**). Additionally, while the total projected adult population growth is lower, the 2012 projections actually call for higher population growth among 25-to-44-year-olds and for seniors aged 65 and over.

Since people of different ages, races and ethnicities have different likelihoods of heading an independent household, differences in their respective growth rates also impact household growth projections. However, many of the distributional changes in population growth balance out in terms of their net effect on household projections. For example, since most of the decline in population growth by race/ethnicity was split between Hispanics, who have the lowest overall headship rates of the four JCHS race/ethnicity groups, and whites, who have the highest, the effects of these declines on household growth somewhat cancelled each other. Similarly, with increases in projected growth for the oldest segment of the population, which has the highest headship rates, and decreases in projected growth for the youngest segment, which has the lowest headship rates, the change in the distribution of population growth by age had only a slight positive impact on household growth.

In summary, much of the difference between the 2010 and 2013 JCHS household projections is due to differences in the underlying projections of the adult population. The 2012 Census Bureau population projections are much lower and range much more narrowly than the 2008 population projections, with the greatest source of difference being much lower immigration assumptions in 2012. Changes to the


distribution of population growth by demographic characteristics worked to mitigate some of the impact on household growth by increasing expected growth among some groups with high household formation rates and reducing growth expected among some groups with low rates.

Overall, the 2012 Census Bureau population projections seem much more reasonable as a basis for the 2013 JCHS household projections than did the Bureau's 2008 predictions for the 2010 JCHS projections; for the 2013 projections, therefore, no adjustments have been made to the Census data. The Bureau's 2012 population projections also justify the JCHS's initial judgment that the 2008 projections were too high, and support the JCHS's decision in 2010 to create its own low-series population projections. Indeed, total adult population growth in the low-series 2012 Census population projection is very similar to the 2010 JCHS low-series population projection, at least through the early 2020s. The Bureau's 2012 high-series projection is lower even than the low series of 2008. Since the JCHS used the 2008 middle-series Census population projection for its high-series household projection, the impact of our switching to use the Bureau's 2012 high-series projections is less than it could have been.

Headship Rates in the 2013 JCHS Household Growth Projections

While most of the difference between the 2010 and 2013 JCHS household growth projections is due to differences in the underlying Census population projections, part of the difference also comes from changes to the headship rates applied to these population projections. In aggregate, headship rate estimates averaged across the years 2011, 2012, and 2013 (used in the 2013 JCHS household projections) are slightly lower than those from 2007-2009 that were used in the 2010 projections (**Figure 9**). As shown in Figure 9, headship rates also appear to have stabilized in aggregate in the early 2010s after having fallen sharply at the end of the previous decade, suggesting that if rates continue to increase in the upcoming years, the assumption that headship rates will be constant for the 2011-2013 period could prove conservative.

Figure 9. Aggregate Headship Rates Used in the 2013 JCHS Household Projections Are Slightly Lower than in the Previous 2010 Projections.





It appears that in aggregate, headship rate changes exerted a downward influence on the 2013 JCHS household growth projections relative to 2010. However, the impact on household growth projections is not as great as these changes in aggregate headship rates suggest. This is because the JCHS's projection methodology does not apply aggregate headship rates to total population growth; rather, headship rates for every five-year age and race/ethnicity group are applied to population figures for each group, and because headship rates differ so much among these groups, changes to headship rates must be considered in combination with changes to the distribution of population growth. Our analysis suggests that changes to the distribution of population growth between the 2008 and 2012 Census Bureau population projections moderated declines in headship rates, since population growth was highest in high headship-rate population groups.


Indeed, between the 2010 and 2013 JCHS household projections, the headship rates did not decline universally for all ages and race/ethnicity groups (**Figure 10**). The largest declines by race and ethnicity were shared among Hispanic and Asian/other persons, while headship rates for whites and blacks increased during this period, largely due to the aging of these populations.

Details Behind the Headship Rate Changes That Occurred Between 2010 and 2013 JCHS Projections

The headship rates used in the 2013 JCHS household growth projections differ from those of the 2010 projections due to concurrent changes in the two underlying data sources. Headship rates are themselves a combination of two components: Census Bureau Population Estimates and household counts from the CPS/ASEC, both of which were affected by the re-benchmarking to the 2010 Census.

The Census Bureau's Population Estimates were the first component to be adjusted to reflect the 2010 Census. Although the Census Bureau's Population Estimates are released monthly, the data series is re-benchmarked every ten years to match total counts from each decennial census which, unlike annual surveys, is intended as a 100 percent count of the US population. Re-benchmarking is necessary because

in between censuses, Population Estimates rely on extrapolations. Therefore, by the end of each decade, Census Population Estimates have relied on nearly a decade of extrapolations and have inevitably drifted and picked up errors that are corrected by the re-benchmarking to the next Census. The 2010 JCHS household growth projections used Population Estimates from 2007, 2008, and 2009 – years that had drifted over time from their previous re-benchmarking.

According to a JCHS analysis comparing the adult population within the Census Bureau's original Population Estimates for July 1, 2009 (benchmarked to the 2000 Census) with revised counts from the Intercensal Population Estimates (benchmarked to the 2010 Census)⁴, the original adult Population Estimates were too low by approximately half a million adults.

But in addition to finding that the original population estimates were about half a million too low by the end of the 2000s, the distribution of households by race/ethnicity was significantly altered by the re-benchmarking. Changes to the size and distribution of the population due to the re-benchmarking affect household growth projections because headship rates vary so significantly by both age and race/ethnicity. A large shift in the distribution of the population by those categories could significantly affect the projected number of households if the population shifts away from groups with high headship rates to those with lower headship rates, or vice versa.





Figure 11b. ...and Census 2010 Also Found More Hispanics and Asian/others, and Fewer non-Hispanic Whites than Originally Estimated

In terms of the impact on the overall household headship rate, changes in the distribution of population by age due to the Census Bureau's 2010 re-benchmarking of its Population Estimates data worked in the opposite direction of changes by race/ethnicity. Specifically, there was a significant downward adjustment to the number of white adults (-1.6 million, -1.0%) and significant upward adjustments in the total number of Hispanic adults (+1.1 million, +3.2%) and non-Hispanic Asian/other adults (+1.1 million, +6.9%). These adjustments are consistent with an underestimation of the total level of immigration that occurred over this decade, and suggest fewer households should have formed, since minority headship rates are lower than those for whites. However, the re-benchmarking also increased the estimate of the number of older adults (who have relatively high headship rates). Specifically, adjustments led to higher estimates of adults aged 45-74 (**Figure 11**). The estimated number of young adults aged 25-34 was adjusted downward significantly by the re-benchmarkings – fully 2 percent lower, a difference of about

840,000 persons. Since headship rises with age, these shifts indicate a higher level of expected household growth.

Household Count Adjustments


The 2010 Census re-benchmarking also affected the total number of households in the CPS/ASEC. As a population-controlled survey, the re-benchmarking affected the CPS/ASEC in a similar manner to the Population Estimates (**Figure 12**). Notably, however, the re-benchmarking of CPS/ASEC data from Census 2000 to new Census 2010 weights increased the 2011 household counts in the CPS/ASEC significantly, by over 1.2 million (+1.05%).

As in the Population Estimates, re-benchmarking adjustments to CPS counts of householders by race/ethnicity increased the number and share of minority households, while adjustments by age increased counts of older households. The greatest upward adjustment in the number of households by race/ethnicity was for Hispanics, which was increased by nearly 800,000, followed by Asian/other

households, which was increased by 600,000. Meanwhile, the count of non-Hispanic white households was revised downward, but unlike in the Population Estimates, this revision was only slightly negative. Most age groups were revised to higher levels, but the estimate of older households increased the most, in particular those aged 55 and over, which increased by nearly 800,000.

Looking at the combined adjustments by age and race/ethnicity, the large net upwards revisions to the counts of Hispanic and Asian/other households were due to sharp upwards revisions in households under age 45 (**Table 3**). Meanwhile, the slight net downward adjustment in non-Hispanic white households overall was the net result of large upwards adjustment to the number of older white households (age 55 and older) and an even larger decrease in the count of younger white households, particularly those aged 25-34.

Summary

The 2013 Joint Center for Housing Studies (JCHS) household projections update the 2010 JCHS projections by using revised population projections from the Census Bureau 2012 Population Projections (released in late 2012 and early 2013) and headship rates derived from the 2011-2013 Current Population Estimates and Current Population Surveys. The 2013 JCHS projections are largely consistent with those from 2013, although there are some differences that follow changes to the underlying data. Overall, the new 2013 projections call for annual household growth rates for 2015-2025 to range from 1.16 million per year in the low series to 1.32 million per year in the high series, not far from the span of 1.15–1.36 million per year in the former 2010 JCHS projections. It is important to recognize that these projections are long-term, demographically-driven baseline trends with many fixed assumptions that could change over time. Headship rates were at low levels in the 2011-2013 period, but at last measure were inching upwards and could increase further with a continued economic recovery – or they could also lose ground with another economic setback. But changes in headship rates would have only a modest impact on the magnitude of projected household growth. Trends in immigration will have a more significant influence on the magnitude of household growth. Economic conditions both in the US and in countries where immigrants originate will have a significant influence on future immigration. Of great importance as well are proposals to fundamentally overhaul federal immigration policy. Both of these factors could alter the shape of household growth dramatically in the future. For now, Census Bureau projections that call for immigration to remain close to current levels appear reasonable and conservative, but bear close observation going forward.


