# Gramlich Fellowship

OPEN TO ALL HARVARD GRADUATE STUDENTS

- Research a key challenge facing organizations in the NeighborWorks America network
- Present findings to practitioners, policy experts and at Harvard
- Publish work as a Joint Center working paper
- \$9,000 for 10 summer weeks plus work during academic year

# Summer Community Service Fellowships (GSD)

## Summer Fellowships in Housing & Community Development (HKS)

- Students arrange for 10-week, full-time fellowships with public or non-profit entities
  - Greater Grove Hall Main Streets
  - National Housing Council
  - The Urban Institute
  - NYC Dept. of Housing Preservation and Development
- \$7,000 for full-time work for 10 weeks
- GSD applications due March 15
- HKS applications due March 24

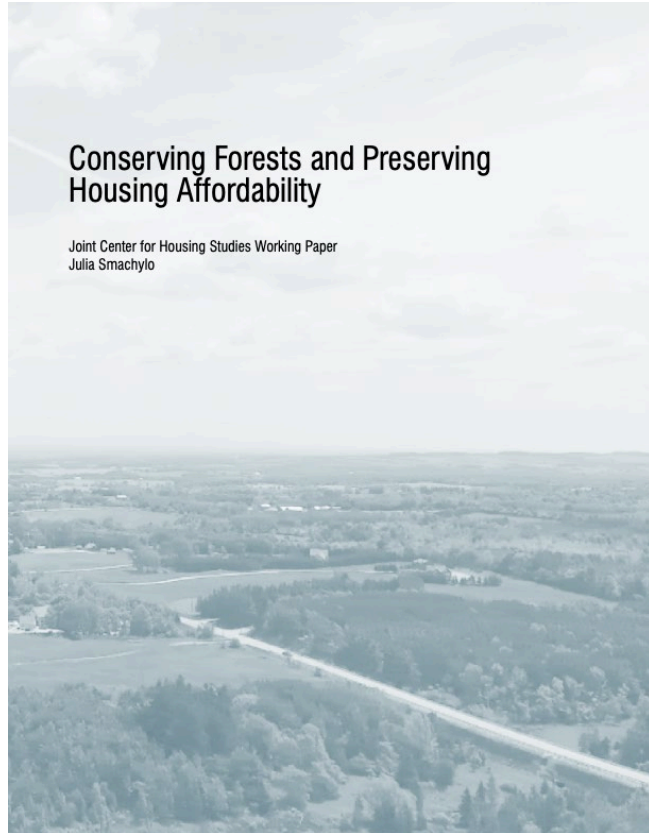

- Provides support during thesis writing stage
- Recipients also present their work at the Center's Housing Research Seminar
- And publish a working paper and blog
- \$5,000 stipend
- Application deadline: March 15

## ABOUT THE STUDENT RESEARCH SUPPORT PROGRAM

Harvard's Joint Center for Housing Studies offers grants of up to \$5,000 to faculty members for research, courses, and other projects related to housing, community development, and other urban issues carried out by Harvard graduate students. The funds can be used to pay graduate students who are working on faculty research projects or who are working on independent research projects supervised by faculty members. The money primarily should be used for compensation but up to 20 percent can be used for other expenses such as data acquisition or travel for field research done in accordance with university travel policies. Recipients are expected to produce a final product, which could be a short paper, case study, course syllabus, planning framework, design portfolio, or multi-media presentation. If appropriate, the work also might be shared with the broader community as a Center publication, public presentation, blog posting, or online presentation.

Applications must be submitted by a faculty member and should include this form as well the faculty member's CV and the CVs of the student (or students) who will be working on the project (if they have been identified). Members of the Joint Center's Faculty Advisory Committee will review the applications for relevance, clarity, significance and feasibility. Awards will also be made with the goal of funding a diversity of topics, methodologies, and academic disciplines. Preference will be given to faculty who have not previously received this award. Recipients will receive their funds in June 2021 and should use them by July 1, 2022.
